Notes: Free parking and toilets. Steady ascent to stone circle 977 ft, including a few short stretches of road, and fields, moorland, woods, hamlets. A few step stiles. Good views on a fine day. Refreshments at Massarella's cafe in Peak Village, outdoor seating available.
