Notes Train on the Hope Valley Line arrives Edale 0948. Pick it up where you like. There are just 10 parking slots at Hope Station, £2.20/day and more on the road at Grindleford - £4.50. Dore & Topley has 130 spaces, free for rail users, and the "excitement" of the Topley Tunnel, but a 15 minute change at Grindleford and £10.70 return. All other options are available, mostly at around £10/head for train and parking. Trains from Hope to Dore run every hour at 35 minutes past. Buses also run between Hope and Edale.

Steady climb on Limestone Way. Good views on a fine day. Return route from Bonsall is mostly wooded and shady.
