Route: Peaktor Lane, Sheepwalk Wood, Stanton Moor, Nine Ladies Stone Circle, Cork Stone, Earl Grey Tower, Stanton Woodhouse,

Notes: Free parking and toilets. Mainly easy ascent but three short, steeper sections. Good views, weather permitting. Easier descent meandering through woods. A few sections of minor road. Nine Ladies stone circle at 977 ft. Can be shortened to 5.5 miles in inclement weather. Refreshments at Peak Village after the walk.

**Notes:** Open moorland walking on reasonable paths. Best place in the country to spot magnificently-antlered male deer and hear their bellow at this peak of the mating season. Warm fires and hot toddies available at Fox House Inn at the end.
